Year 9 Tasmania Tour

When: December

The Year 9 Tasmania Tour is a 5 day trip to Historic Tasmania that takes in both natural and man made sites. Students travel on The Spirit of Tasmania and visit Port Arthur's historical sites, take a night tour of the penal settlement, cruise The Isle of the Dead, discover the workings of The Cadbury Chocolate Factory, visit the many famous areas of Richmond, Huonville, Franklin, Geeveston, Cataract Gorge, and Eagle Hawk Neck to visit the Blowhole and Tessalated Pavements. Students will also experience the newly developed Tahune Forest Airwalk, Salamanca Place, Constitution Dock and Battery Point.



Approximate Cost: \$700.00

Year 9 Urban Experience

When: June



Students in Year 9 have the opportunity to participate in a 5 day intensive tour of the City of Melbourne. All Year 9's at the College are invited to attend and are placed in groups of 25 led by two staff members. While on this tour, students participate in a range of different activities (ie: Urban Seed, The MCG, Eureka Sky Deck and Melbourne Aquarium) that build on their understanding and appreciation of their city. Participants are encouraged to explore as much of Melbourne City as they can. Links are made between this experience and curriculum at the College.
