Fiction

We have a wide range of books, arranged alphabetically.

Non Fiction Books are arranged in Dewey decimal order. Popular books may be on a four day loan only.

Reference books are available for use in the Library, but not for loan. They include general and subject specific encyclopedias, dictionaries and atlases.

Newspapers

We have back issues of *The Age* and *Herald Sun*. Many Australian newspapers can be accessed through the school intranet or website. You can print, email or save the full articles you need.

Electronic Resources and data bases for project work can be found through the Library website.

Periodicals

The Library subscribes to a range of magazines. The most recent issue is not for loan, however, the other issues may be borrowed.

Computer Use

The computers in the Library area can be used for school related work. Library staff can give help with using the computers.

Printing credit may be purchased at the General Office. Printing costs 10c for black and white and 50c for colour. Internet use is free but guidelines apply.

Photocopying is available for students in the Library. Photocopy cards can be purchased at the General Office. The costs are the same as for printing.

Book Club

We have active Book Clubs on each campus. Book Club gives students the opportunity to share their enjoyment of reading by discussing what they are reading, selecting books for the Library to buy and excursions.



Borrowing

Years 7-10 students may borrow 4 items. Book club members may borrow more.

VCE students may borrow 7 items.

You will need your student card to borrow. Loans are generally for 14 days. Although some items that are in demand are four day loans only.

Students with overdue books may not borrow until books are returned. Reservations can be made at the front desk.
