



SCHOOL PROFILE

Rowville Secondary College is a large dual campus secondary college located in Melbourne's South Eastern suburbs, within the City of Knox. The Western Campus opened in 1990 and provides for students in years 7-12. The school's Eastern Campus opened in 1996 and principally caters for students in years 7-10 and senior Rowville Sports Academy and Rowville Institute of the Arts students. The school has a total enrolment of approximately 1840 students across both campuses, with predominantly five neighbourhood primary schools.

Rowville Secondary College aims to provide modern, vibrant and challenging opportunities to all students, through a curriculum that dynamically incorporates students' interests, abilities and future directions.

Staff and leadership structure at Rowville Secondary College reflects the continuing efforts to ensure that the college is unified despite being located in two different physical locations.
