

Senior School 'Head Start' Program

In order to best prepare our students for the demands of their studies next year, a two week '**Head Start' Program** has been organised for all Senior School students from **Monday 28th November to Friday 9th December**. Students undertaking a **VCE program** will attend for the full two weeks, whilst **VCAL and SBAT** students are required to attend on the Monday and Tuesday of **each** of the two weeks of the program. It is very important that all returning and newly enrolled students attend this **compulsory** program. Any student who is unable to attend any part of the 'Head Start' Program needs to provide an explanatory note beforehand so that alternative arrangements can be made.

At the beginning of the 'Head Start' Program students will receive a confirmation of their 2012 course and an individualised timetable when they sign in at the **Senior Study Centre** at their base campus on **Monday 28th November at 9:00am**.

During the program students will attend classes in each of their 2012 subjects. Students will be expected to attend all scheduled classes. In these classes students will be provided with an overview of each subjects' coursework, school assessed tasks, study design material and holiday homework that needs to be completed during the Christmas holidays. They will also commence the first weeks of study for their 2012 subjects. Students who do not attend the 'Head Start' Program or who fail to complete the introductory coursework may be disadvantaged next year. Students who have holiday employment must arrange to have the program dates free.

Note: Attendance at orientation week is compulsory.
