



## 2021 Enrolment Process

The Rowville Sports Academy is a full time integrated academic and sporting program offering placement in one of our sports which are Australian Football, Basketball, Cricket, Football (Soccer), Golf, Netball, Tennis and Volleyball. This program allows talented and passionate young male and female student athletes to develop their sporting talent while receiving their secondary education concurrently. Rowville Sports Academy employs elite level coaches, has great facilities, employs partners to provide athletic development, strength and conditioning and physiotherapy services and has great success with developing talent.

All students wishing to apply for an enrolment opportunity into the Rowville Sports Academy must complete a multi-step process. Students must attend a Try-Out for each of the sporting programs in which they wish to be considered for enrolment.

Due to the current global pandemic of Coronavirus COVID-19, and the regulated social distancing and isolation, all group Try-Out Elite Coaching Camps have been temporarily postponed until restrictions are relaxed and when we feel it is safe to hold trials in person.

So, at this time students that are seeking an enrolment into Year 7 in 2021 must complete a Remote Trial.

Please complete the following steps;

- All interested students must submit an Expression of Interest via the Rowville Secondary College website **by Monday 25 May 2020**; <https://www.rowvillesc.vic.edu.au/expression-of-interest-form/>
- Forward through a copy of your most recent full school report (this will be the end of year report for 2019) and a copy of your birth certificate or passport to; [rsa@rowvillesc.vic.edu.au](mailto:rsa@rowvillesc.vic.edu.au)
- **For Year 7 in 2021 enrolment application** - Once your Expression of Interest has been received, RSA will send you through further information and instruction on how to complete a Remote Trial for each sport that you are interested in applying for. This Remote Trial will be slightly different for each sport that is offered by RSA and will be multi-faceted. - This can include video evidence of you performing specific skills and drills, references from your community based sporting coach, questionnaire, and evidence of your sporting history and achievements.
- If school resumes and we are given approval to do so a physical small group Try-Out (adhering to social-distancing regulations) is likely to form part of the trial process. If this can proceed prior to Department of Education deadlines for advising current Year 6 students of their year 7 placement we will put things in place and advise families of the details of those. The only possible time for this to occur within these required timelines is in the Term 2 School Holiday Break. Irrespective of whether this is possible, all students seeking entry to year 7 in 2021 will need to complete a Remote Trial as well.
- **For Students applying for Years 8 -12 in 2021** – Please follow the above application process outlined in point 1 and 2. A physical small group Try Out will proceed later in Term 3 / Term

4 in 2020 or if we have clearance to do so, an RSA Elite Sports Camp will be held to determine placements in 2021 for these year levels.

- All applicants' submissions and trials will be assessed by the RSA Coaching Teams, RSA Operations Manager and Rowville Secondary College Principal Team.
- Please note there is a fee payable for trials and Elite Sports Camps.
