Orientation Phase of Transition - August - November:

- Information is collected from your child's Primary School.

- Year 7 students have a learning mentor at the start of each day and be a first point of contact for families.

Year 7 Induction


- After their first day on the 31st January your child will complete an induction program with their Learning Mentors and classroom teachers.
